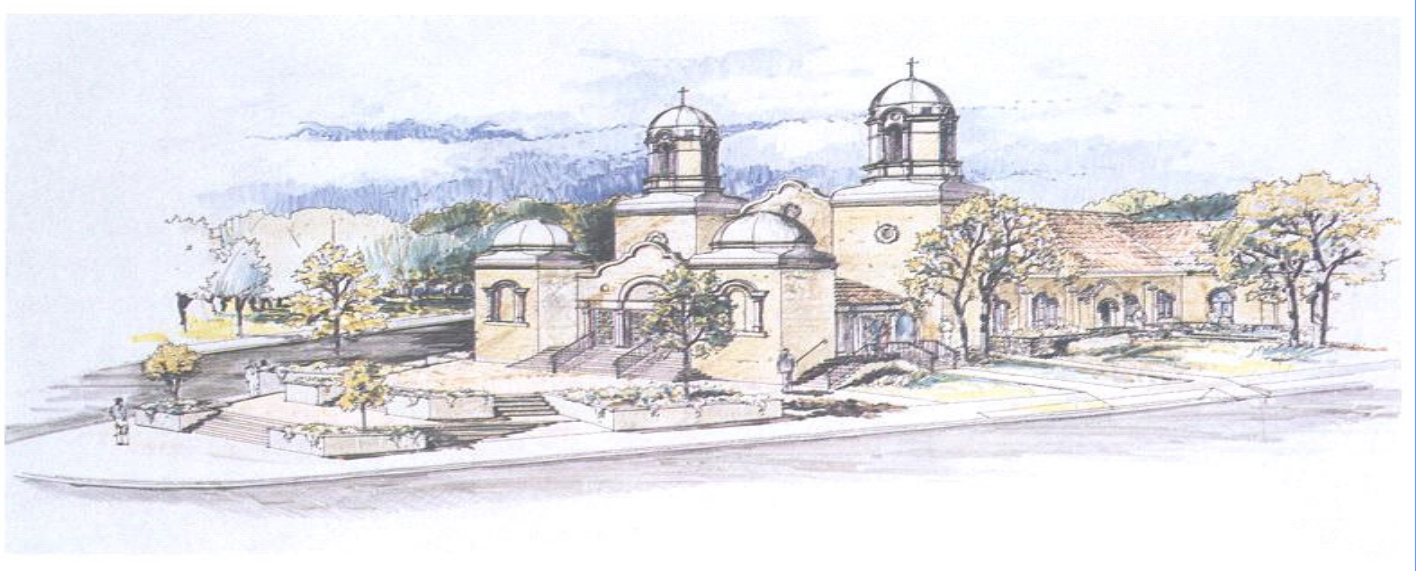

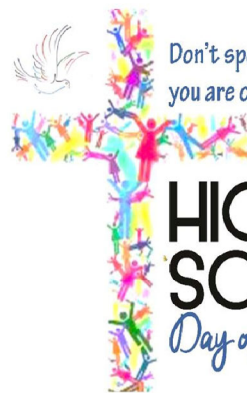

Project Rachel

"Project Rachel will conduct a 2-day training in post-abortion ministry. The workshop will take place on Saturdays from 9-4:30, on June 3 and June 10. The workshop is for people interested in carrying out ministry, either as part of the Archdiocesan team or as part of local teams that will operate under the auspices of parishes with the approval and support of the pastor. This training is only for those with desire to be part of a team that facilitates abortion recovery weekly groups or day retreats for women and men. Space is limited and cost is low (\$25 covers the retreat/support group materials). The first Saturday will cover the overview of abortion's aftermath and the nature of recovery in general, the nuts and bolts of starting the ministry and hosting a recovery group. On the second Saturday you will learn and practice how to carry out the program. There will be light required reading materials for the week between, and some videos that can be watched at any time.
